Attention 3rd, 4th & 5th Class parents,

The Solstice Performance for your children will take place on Wednesday, November 30th at 7.30pm in the Solstice Arts Centre, Navan. Tickets are available direct from the Solstice Arts Centre (046)9092300, €15 each or four for €50.

All pupils must be in the theatre for 5pm sharp, dressed for the performance. Ard Rí pupils wear their navy school trousers or pinafore with a Christmas jumper and Santa hat. Children must wear school shoes (black-give them a wee polish⁽ⁱ⁾) and girls wear navy socks or tights. Please be mindful of children overheating and wear a light t-shirt or vest under the jumper. Pupils enter through the main theatre door. Parents should be aware that the theatre is closed to the public until 6.30pm and they will not be allowed into the theatre until then.

The show will end at approximately 9.30pm. The children will be brought to the foyer school by school and parents can collect children in the main foyer.

Pupils can bring books, DSs or portable games to entertain them when not on stage. Label the device clearly! We will do our best to keep these items safe but be aware all devices are brought at your own risk.

There will be a short break between the dress rehearsal and the show so pupils can bring a packed lunch. Choirs will not have access to The Solstice Café in the foyer so pupils should have sufficient food and drinks to last them for the evening. Drinks should be in line with school lunches; sandwich, fruit, water, etc. No fizzy drinks or sweets and chewing gum is strictly forbidden.

A professional DVD will be made of the performance. These can be ordered and paid for in the foyer on the night of the show and orders will be delivered to the school before the end of term.
