We ask children wear tracksuits on the PE days assigned to their class <u>only</u>. Please ensure your child wears their white polo t-shirt on tracksuit days. These days will change as the year progresses.

<u>After School Club:</u> After school is back. It begins for Senior Infants on Monday 03.09.2018 and will begin for Junior Infants on Monday 10.09.2018 (only if they are ready for the longer day). <u>School Photographer:</u> Memory Lane Photography will visit the school on Thursday 13.09.2018. All children will be photographed (both alone and with their siblings) but there is no obligation to buy photographs. Junior Infants and 6<sup>th</sup> Class will have a group photograph taken. All children must wear full uniform on the day. Don't forget to brush their hair!!!

<u>Ard Rí Kickhams</u>: Training for the Ard Rí Kickhams will run on Fridays from Friday 21.09.2018 to Friday 19.10.2018. Junior and Senior Infants will play on the school yard from 1.40-2.30.  $1^{st}$ - $6^{th}$  will go to the field for after school sports from 2.40-3.30. This event will be weather permitting of course. Junior and Senior Infant children attending Kickhams can wear their school tracksuits on Fridays.  $1^{st}$ - $6^{th}$  will get dirty at these sessions so should bring sports clothes with them to school and will be given time to change before sports begin. We would love as much parental involvement as possible in order to make this a success. No experience is necessary. There will be a  $\leq 2$  cover charge per session. All this money goes towards maintaining our sports equipment.
