<b>Interpersonal</b>	Check-in with your grandparents (or an older person you know) via technology. Prepare a list of questions in advance of the call- <i>How are you? What was school like when you were my age? Were there viruses around then? What did you do?</i> Record, then transcribe and illustrate the information received.	English SESE Art	For younger children engaging the older person in conversation and drawing a picture could be the response. An older child could write a newspaper report on the interview and draw a picture to go with it.
<b>Verbal</b>	Reading; Read quietly to yourself, read to younger siblings, read-aloud	English	Mute the TV and switch on subtitles!!
<b>Logical</b>	Build an amazing hotel to stay in! You might use LEGO or upcycled cardboard boxes from your recycling bin or you might just like to draw your concept on paper. Discuss as you go and label your work.  Continue Planet Maths/Mental Maths (Approx. 1 page per day)	Art SESE English Maths	Older ones might research some famous hotels around the world- e.g. The Plaza NYC (the family could watch Home Alone 2)
<b>Naturalistic</b>	See what kind of birds there are in your garden or on your daily walk. Name them and research what kind of food they like. <u>Here's a start</u> ; A Blackbird visits my garden. Blackbirds love apples- split an apple and leave it out to see what happens.	SESE	The younger ones can just learn the names of a few garden birds. Older children create a journal (a few notebook pages stapled together) with notes and pictures of observations made in nature.
