Well done everyone on a super first week!

Thankfully there has been good news this week in relation to the lifting of COVID-19 Restrictions. We have received a lot of inquiries from parents regarding extra-curricular activities, such as sports, After-School Club for Junior and Senior Infants and community events. There is no change in practice for the moment. We will update you once we have reviewed the official Department of Education guidance.

Enrolment:

- At Ard Rí Community NS we have 289 pupils from 206 families across 11 classrooms. We would require 295 pupils on 30.09.2021 to gain our 12th teacher next year. There are some places available in Junior Infants, Senior Infants, 1st Class and 3rd Class. If you know anyone looking for a school place for these classes, please ask them to give me a call.
- The enrolment process for next September will begin next month. If you have a child starting Junior Infants in September 2022 please complete this <u>Expression of</u> <u>Interest Form.</u>

When the time comes for your daughter to use the facility please ensure you have coached her and that she is comfortable and confident in doing so.
