This 7-week program will introduce many of the fundamental skills of Hurling with the addition of children having the opportunity to decorate their own hurls. This gives less sporty kids a real involvement in the program.



Why Kids Don't Stay Hurling / Camogie It's NOT FUN! Coached skills above their level Afraid of getting hurt Lose Interest Their friends don't play Never learned the basic skills Started too late



7-Week Skill Development

DRIBBLE

Kids will learn how to control the ball on the ground using the hurl. This is a great way to build confidence with ball control and learn how to develop their wrist strength.

LIFTING

Kids will learn the skills of lifting the ball with both the jab lift and the roll lift. This supports many other skills that will be taught along the way.

SOLO

Kids will learn how to control the hurl when balancing an object (bean bag progressing to a ball). This skill starts off with having a good "wiggle".

THE "C" STRIKE

Kids can not wait to be able to hit the ball. in the Camán & Play program they will learn how to do it in the right way!







Kids will develop the skills of throwing and catching which is the fundamental of handpassing as they progress. Hand-eye coordination is a massive part of hurling and it all starts with throwing and catching.

Is It Expensive

Camán & Play is delivered to the school with only one cost passed on, everything else is covered by Meath Coaching & Games.

The only cost involved in getting started is buying the hurls.

We have organised a fantastic price of €5 per hurl from a supplier and we can do everything for you including; placing an order, hurl collection, and delivery to your school.

For a class of 25 children, the total cost of the program is €125
