- School will close for Christmas holidays at 12pm on Wednesday 22nd December. To avoid congestion in the car park classes Junior Infants to 2nd will be dismissed a few minutes before 12pm and classes 3rd to 6th will be dismissed at 12pm.
- I have no insider information, however to be prepared for the *very unlikely event* school buildings do not reopen to pupils in January we will be sending home a small folder of work so teachers could seamlessly begin remote teaching on Seesaw if required.
- Parent teacher meetings will be held by telephone call on week commencing Monday 24th
