Enrolment: Since 2010 we have seen our school grow from strength to strength. We are working with architects on some very early stage plans for our new school on Academy Street. We currently have 290 pupils from 203 families enrolled at the school. Every year we present our pupil numbers to the Department of Education and they will allocate us a number of teachers. It is important we work hard to attract prospective families to the community so we can fill classes. We currently have a small number of places in Junior Infants for September and our current Junior Infants to 3rd class. Our location is very much hidden from view. We are a well-kept secret!
