Last Few Points to Note June 2022

Hi everyone,

Our projected enrolment for September 2022 currently stands at 312 pupils. Last Thursday we were notified by the Department of Education we have been provisionally sanctioned our 12th classroom teacher. This is great news. A minimum enrolment of 309 pupils on 30th September 2022 will hold this 12th post. If we have fewer than 309 pupils we will return to 11 teachers after the October 2022 mid-term! There would be possibility of appeal etc.

Even though the margin is tight we are now preparing to open 12 classrooms in September. We will open two Junior Infant classes and there will be no change for pupils moving into Senior Infants to Third Class.

There will be some change for pupils going into 4th, 5th and 6th Classes. From September these pupils will learn in 4 classes as follows:

Pupils have had great success learning in multi-grade classes at Ard Rí CNS over the years. Most of these children have learned in multi grade before. Our teachers have built up good experience in teaching multi grade. There are opportunities for pupils to develop leadership skills, be exposed to more challenging topics and revise content from previous years. When we reconfigure classes we do our best to find balance and incorporate friendships.
