<u>Student Direct Costs 2024/2025:</u> Schoolbooks for children in Irish primary schools, are now provided to every child for free. The school will use the grant to cover the cost of schoolbooks, workbooks, copybooks, classroom related resources, shared books, photocopying and Art&Craft.

Last year parents paid for music lessons through Music Generation. We will not be continuing with Music Generation. We have purchased a Music Programme called Dabbledoo Music. The cost of the programme will be paid using the book grant and it will be delivered by our own teachers.

The cost to parents for school year 23/24 will be €15 per child. A Way2Pay bill will be raised on your account in the coming weeks. This money will directly pay for:
