



Annual Admission Notice 2027/2028

The following Annual Admission Notice has been prepared by the board of management of Ard Rí Community National School in respect of the admission of students to the school for the school year 2027/2028. This notice was published on 23/09/2026.

Note: The figures set out below in relation to Junior Infants are subject to increase dependent on the overall student teacher ratio in the school at the time of the administration of the school's admission process for applications to the Junior Infant class.

All applications to the **Junior Infants or the Special Class (for ALL class groups)** in Ard Rí CNS will only be accepted from **Thursday the 01/10/2026** and the closing date for receipt of applications is **11am on Friday 23/10/2026**. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to **Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class** in Ard Rí CNS (other than to the Special Class), will only be accepted from **Monday 17/05/2027** and the closing date for receipt of applications is **11am on Friday 04/06/2027**. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy. Equally, any transfer applications received during the current academic year, *i.e.* before June 2027, to transfer into a class



immediately, will be treated as a late application where the application window for transferring into the school for the academic year 2026/2027 took place during the previous academic year and anyone who did not receive a place at that time was put on a waiting list. Therefore, any available places that arise in that class during the 2026/2027 academic year will be filled from that waiting list, until that list expires at the end of the academic year 2026/2027.

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a child is seeking a place in the Special Class and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.

All applicants to the Junior Infants and/or Special Class for the following academic year will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	04/11/2026
Successful applicants to the Junior Infants Group and/or Special Class must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Ard Rí CNS by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	13/11/2026
All transfer applications to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class other than to the Special Class, for the following academic year will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	11/06/2027
Successful transfer applicants to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class other than to the Special Class, in the following academic year must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Ard Rí CNS by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	18/06/2027
Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above, or as stated on any letter of offer, may result in the offer being withdrawn.	

Ard Rí CNS will cooperate with the National Council for Special Education in the performance by the Council of its functions under the Education for Persons with Special Educational Needs Act 2004 relating to the provision of



education to children with special educational needs, including in particular by the provision and operation of a special class or classes when requested to do so by the Council.

Ard Rí CNS will comply with any direction served on the patron or the board of management, as the case may be, under section 37A and any direction served on the board of management under section 67(4B) of the Education Act.

Last year the school was oversubscribed and the following is a breakdown of the award of places:
