Way2Pay

The cost of 6 lessons plus bus transport is €47. You will receive a payment request for this event from Way2Pay. Simply click the link on the SMS to pay in three easy steps. For this event payment will be seen as permission to attend. Way2Pay has a facility which allows you to pay in instalments.

Ard Rí activities are run at cost price. Both the pool and bus prices have increased since last year.

If comfortable, on swimming days, your child should wear their swimming togs under their school tracksuit. Ensure your child has a swimming cap as they will not be admitted to the water without one. Please have all items of clothing clearly labelled. Encourage your child to practice changing their clothes independently at home. Your child's swimming bag must be big enough to fit all their belongings including footwear as all items are stored in lockers during lessons.



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This is a great opportunity for your child to practice independence. There will be plenty of school staff available to assist children if required. We aim for all children to take part in swimming without parental support. If you must assist your child in their changing for swimming fill in the request for attendance form below and return it to your child's class teacher. Aquatics is one of the strands of Physical Education. Should a child be unable to attend aquatics, due to a medical condition or other reasons, a letter must be written to the school requesting exemption.
